### **Warrenton Revitalization Committee Meeting Tuesday, February 18, 2014**

The Warrenton Revitalization Committee met Tuesday, February 18, 2014 at 5:30 PM at the Warrenton Rural Fire Department. Members attending were: Patricia Allen, Cheryl Bell, Cathleen (Rose) Derring, Bob Shingler, Ernie Fleming, Crystal Smith and Selena Mooring. Commissioners attending were Woody King, Mary Hunter, Kimberly Harding and John Mooring. Also present was Robert Davie, Town Administrator, Charla Duncan and Michael Coffman. A quorum was present.

Commissioner King asked if the Nominating Committee had a recommendation for the open position to replace Tim Ennis. The Committee recommends Michael Coffman. Michael Coffman agreed to serve and a motion to submit his nomination will be added to the agenda for the March BOC meeting was made by John Mooring and seconded by Mary Hunter and unanimously approved.

Charla Duncan was introduced as the new Direction of the Warren County Chamber of Commerce.

A rain date for the Christmas parade was discussed, which would be the following day if needed. Kimberly Harding asked about changing the time of the parade to daylight hours. It was deemed more festive with lights at the current afternoon time.

Springfest assignments were made for stage setup, kiosk manning, candy purchase, advertising purchase, etc. Advertising was discussed and agreed that \$850 dollars will be spent on Springfest with \$400 going to the Warren Record, \$300 to Daily Dispatch and \$150 to radio station out of South Hill. A press release will be composed and sent along with advertising.

Music and sound setup is arranged with Butch Meek, the Abbots, Warren County Travelers and the Grass Street Bluegrass band. Sponsors will be emailed forms shortly. Interest has already been expressed by vendors. The Chamber of Commerce intends to provide beer at Springfest.

A contest with prizes is planned for shop owners and their window presentations.

Because of timing and proximity to Springfest, the Easter Bonnet Parade will not be held this year.

Harvest Market is scheduled for October 11, 2014.
